Some lenses are available on a pay as you go basis- this gives added flexibility for those who may only want to wear lenses on an occasional basis, typically daily disposable lenses for sports.

Daily disposable lenses can be purchased from £30.00 for 30 pairs; you are free to purchase as many as you require. We do of course require that we check your eyes regularly. These appointments are charged at the full rate of £35 per appointment.

An eye examination is normally required every two years and contact lens assessment every year. If you wish to wear contact lenses for more than 2 days a week it is advantageous to join our monthly plan which entitles you to these examinations at no additional cost.

STATE OF THE ART EXAMINATION EQUIPMENT

We have two consulting rooms fitted with state of the art equipment. We use computerised letter charts, a video imaging microscope, a retinal camera and can keep photographic images with your clinical records. This enables us to ensure your eyes have the best possible care, and monitor any subtle changes in the health of your eyes while you are wearing contact lenses.

- Book a contact lens assessment appointment

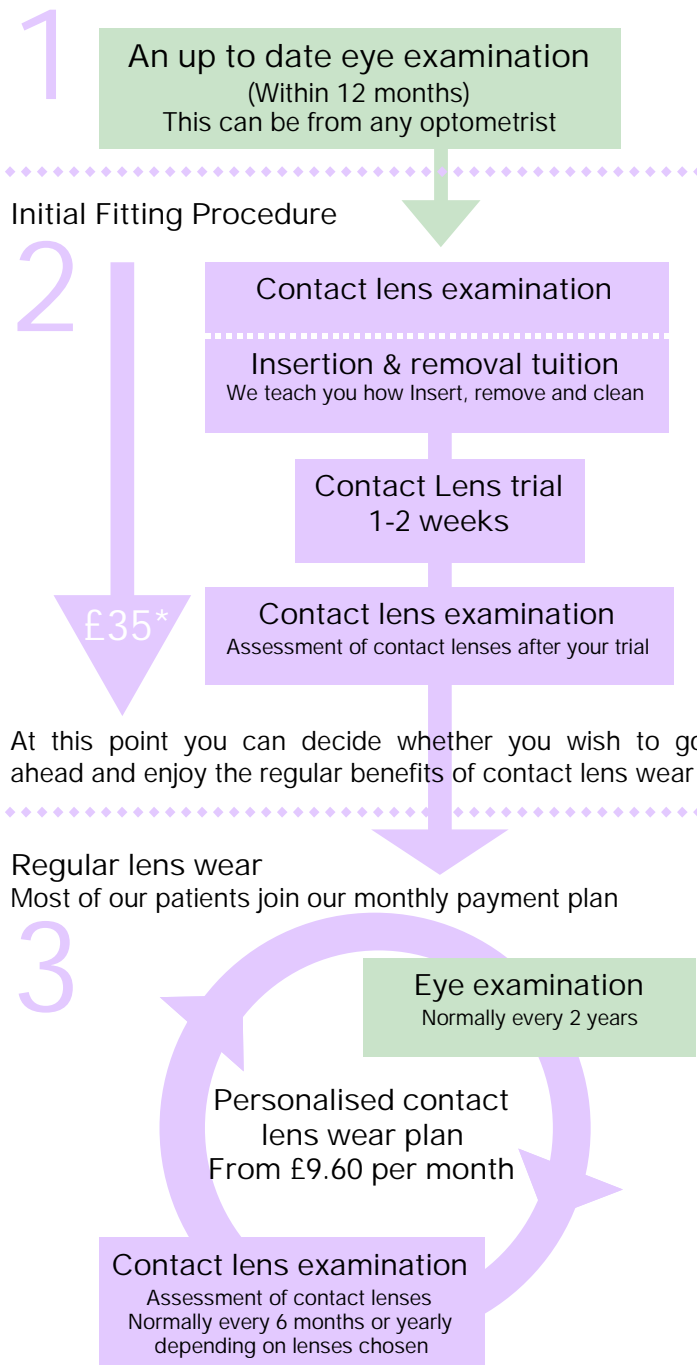
The assessment fee is from £35* and includes:
